What's the Weather Like?

Scenario: To talk about the weather

Vocabulary: Weather

Level: A1 Elementary

Time: 15 minutes

Students often know the vocabulary (rainy, windy) but are unable to correctly form sentences, especially with appropriate tenses.

Pre-teach key points:

- *Rain* and *snow* are usually verbs.
- When we talk about the past, we say *it snowed* not *it was snowing*, because it is a completed event.
- *Cloudy*, *sunny* and *foggy* are adjectives.

Additional Teaching Ideas

This is a great opportunity for a review of basic tenses.

You could review past progressive and simple. (*It snowed yesterday. It was snowing when I got up*).

You could also review the future. (*It will snow tomorrow* (prediction) and *it's going to rain* - it's about to happen or it was forecast to happen).
